

# SUMMARY OF CHANGES

CCR 145-2

Junior Reserve Officers' Training Corps Program, Organization, Administration, Operation, Training and Support

This revision —

- Changes “Junior ROTC” to read “JROTC” throughout this regulation.
- Reemphasizes reporting requirements for initial, subsequent, and final SIR reports (chap 1).
- Introduces the JROTC Unit Management System Program (JUMS) and the JROTC Communication Information Management System (JCIMS) (chap 2).
- Adds detailed responsibilities of Director of Army Instructor and includes a separate section of the weight control program (chap 4).
- Updates quality training; emphasizes the systematic approach to training within the program of instruction, and outlines the leadership unit of instruction. (chap 5).
- Adds JROTC Fund Raising Activities (chap 6).
- Adds JROTC Unit Inspection Program (chap 7).
- Adds the four-step training and professional development plan for JROTC School of Cadet Command (JSOCC); includes guidance for the selection and qualifications of Instructor Interviewers; and, addresses minimum distances on .177 and .22 rifle ranges (chap 8).
- Adds the prohibited wear of the Army uniform for JROTC instructors and cadets in public; corrects the proper placement of insignia on cadet uniforms; and, updates the criteria for the academic achievement awards (chap 10).
- Adds Distinctive JROTC Instructor Awards and the Instructor of the Year Awards; updates the criteria for the Sons of the American Revolution award; and authorizes the wear of Civilian Marksmanship Awards (chap 11).
- Adds format for Camp AAR (Appendix J).
- Updates precedence of wear of JROTC ribbons (Appendix M).
- Adds rifle marksmanship qualification awards (Appendix O).
- Adds the JUMS and JCIMS definitions to the glossary.
