CHAPTER 1 INSPECTOR GENERAL

1. CONCEPT.

a. The US Army Fourth Region Inspector General is designated as the ROTC Advanced Camp Inspector General (IG).

b. The IG will publish a policy letter stating office hours. Cadet regiments will post this information in each platoon barracks and regimental orderly room, and all camp staff sections will post in each staff building.

c. Cadets and cadre may contact the Camp/Region Inspector General for assistance with complaints and redress of grievances; however, they will be encouraged to use their Chain of Command first whenever possible.

d. The IG office will provide surveys to each Regiment to be completed by the cadets.

2. PROCEDURES.

a. Individuals who desire to visit the IG need not discuss their problem with any other activity or individual. Commanders, supervisors, etc., will neither deny personnel permission to see the IG nor will they require the individual to provide a reason why he desires to see the IG.

b. Individuals will obtain permission through the established Chain of Command to absent themselves from training or duty prior to leaving their assigned duty station to visit the IG. Should scheduled activities prevent an individual from seeing the IG during normally scheduled hours, the individual may make an appointment, at a time convenient to the requester, by calling the IG.

c. Regiments will receive a survey during each phase of training (Inprocessing, Field preparation, and Completion of Platoon STX). The IG will give surveys to Regiments one-day prior of each ending phase. The cadet chain-of-command will administer them to the platoons. Once the platoon completes the survey, the cadet administering the survey will collect both the completed survey and blank (unused) forms, seal the envelope and return them to the orderly room. Someone from the orderly room will deliver the sealed envelopes to the Inspector General's office NLT 1000 the morning after completion.

d. Survey results will be distributed approximately 24 hrs later to the Camp Commander, Deputy Camp Commander, Camp Sergeant Major, Commandant of Cadets, Chief of Staff, Chief of Training and the RTO. The Commandant of Cadet will provide significant feedback to each committee as needed.
