SUBJECT: Change to HQDA Letter 385-91-1, Inspection and  
Evaluation of U.S. Army Indoor Firing Ranges

1. Proponent and exception authority. The proponent of this letter is the Director of the Army Staff. The Director of the Army Staff has the authority to approve exceptions to this letter which are consistent with controlling law and regulation. The Director of the Army Staff may delegate this authority in writing to a division chief within the proponent agency in the grade of colonel or the civilian equivalent.

2. Justification. This change extends the expiration date of HQDA Letter 385-91-1. This extension is required to ensure that the policy and procedures for inspecting and evaluating U.S. Army indoor firing ranges remain in effect until revised AR 385-63 is published. Upon publication, revised AR 385-63 will supersede this and the basic HQDA letter.

3. HQDA Letter 385-91-1, 26 March 1991, is changed as follows:
